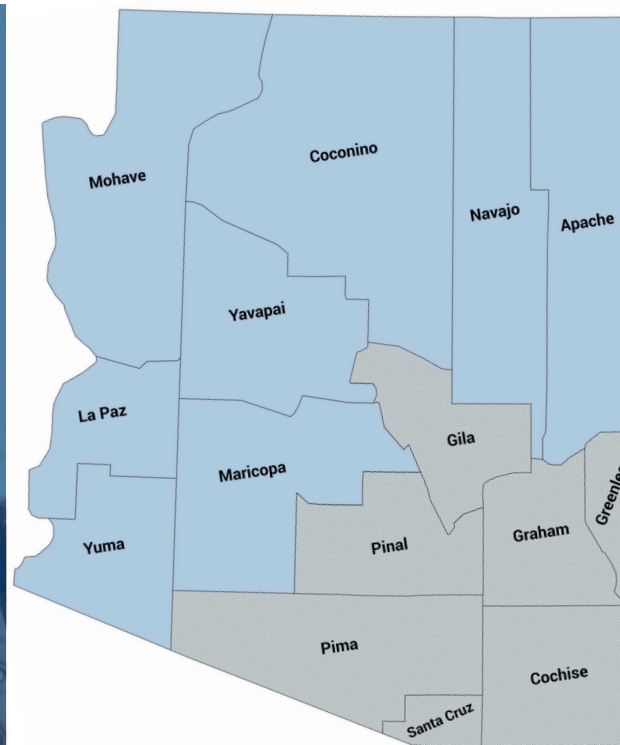


# About Us

# Get on Board!

- Each volunteer is appointed by the Court to a 5-member board.
- Each board meets one weekday per month via the virtual platform Zoom.
- Some rural county boards meet less often than once a month.
- Each board meets for approximately 6-8 hours.
- Volunteers spend 6-8 hours a month reviewing case information prior to the board meeting.

## Requirements

- Volunteers must be at least 21 years old.
- Volunteers must pass a fingerprint background check.
- Volunteers must participate in an initial orientation training within six months of being appointed.
- Volunteers must earn six hours of continuing education annually.
