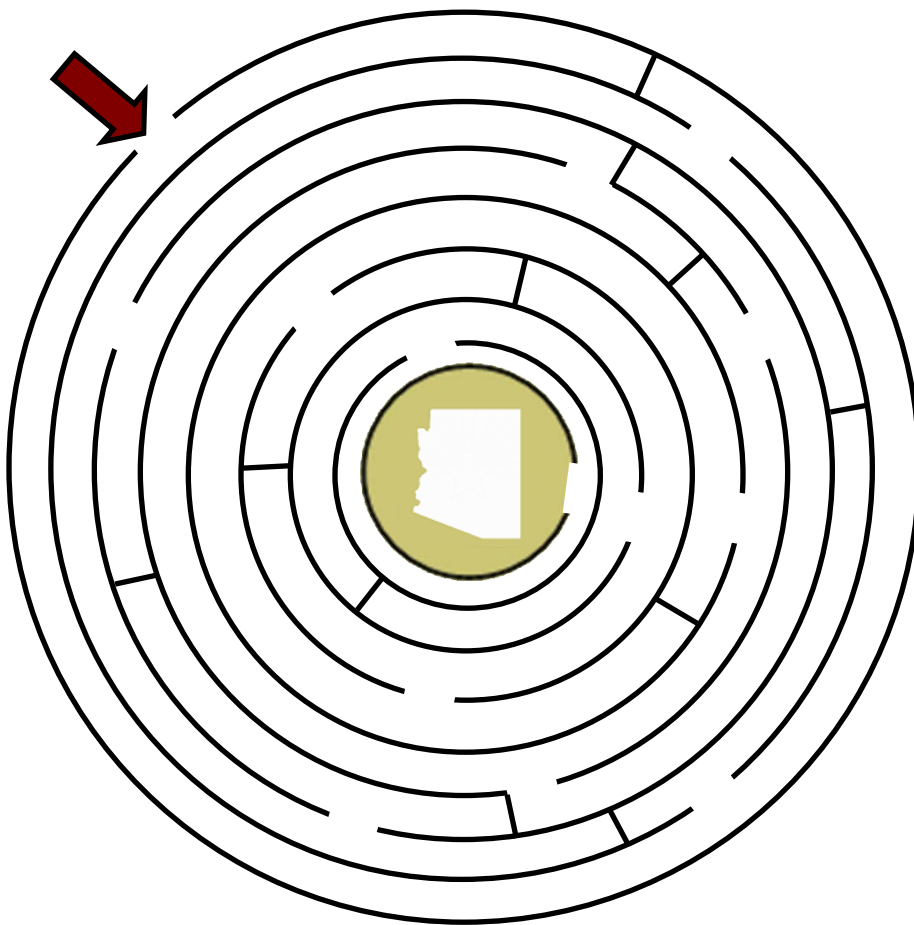


# What it Takes to be Governor
