Negative peer pressure: 1. Max is telling me, we shouldn't study for our math test and copy someone else.

School consequences: refer to your student handbook. Possibly lunch detention.

Legal consequences: No legal consequences.

Negative peer pressure: 2. Ana is inviting me to a college party where there will be alcohol.

School consequences: none because the event is not taking place at school.

Legal consequences: fine and loss of driving privileges upon conviction.

Negative peer pressure: 1. Amy brings beer to school in her pack back.

School consequences: refer to the student handbook. Possibly suspension or expulsion.

Legal consequences: major offense and can stay in the student's record.

Negative peer pressure: 3. Juan tells me to taste the beer his dad has in the refrigerator.

School consequences: none because the event is not taking place at school.

Legal consequences: the minor may face fines, probation, community service, and alcohol education or treatment. The adult could face an arrest.
